

RESIDENT LIST OF APPROVED/REQUIRED POSSESSIONS

The following list has been approved by Center Staff as to what Residents **may** or **may not** bring into the Center.

HYGIENE AND LAUNDRY ITEMS ARE SOLD THROUGH COMMISSARY -- Clothing or caps are to be free of Logo's. Any and all donations from family will only be taken on Tuesdays between 8:00 a.m. and 4:45 p.m. (money, clothing, etc.)

UNDERGARMENTS

- 8 - of each (briefs, undershirts, socks, pantyhose, bras)
- 2 - slippers or athletic supporters

SLEEPWEAR

- 2 - pair of pajamas/warmups and/or shorts (permitted only in sleeping quarters) Shorts may be worn to work with the approval of Employer and Employment Specialist.
- 1 - bathrobe

SHOES

- 3 - pair only - any combination (tennis shoes, high heels, boots, rubber boots, crocs, etc.) Flip-flops are to worn in the shower/room only.

PANTS, BLUE JEANS,

- 10 - combination (No capris)

DRESSES, SKIRTS

- 5 - combination - to be worn below the knee.

SHIRTS, WORK SHIRTS, BLOUSES, OUTERWEAR

- 10 - any combination - T-shirts with pockets will be considered outerwear (1 Black Only)
Must Be Tucked In -white and black T-shirts without pockets only to be worn as under garments (1 Black Only)
No Camouflage clothing allowed
No sleeveless shirts, no muscle shirts, no spaghetti strap shirts, no camisoles (all shirts must have a regular sleeve)

SUITS

- 1 - Men's or Women's

CAPS, HEADGEAR

- 2 - any combination (work head gear or cap no logo for outside use only.)

HANDKERCHIEFS

- 2 - white only

BELTS

- 2 - plain (black or brown only)

JEWELRY

- 1 - wristwatch (no camouflage)
- 2 - pairs of pierced earrings (women Residents only)
- 1 - wedding ring set (if appropriate)

JACKETS, WINDBREAKERS, COATS, RAINCOATS (not to be worn inside the Center). **Small logos are allowed.**

- 1 - lightweight
- 1 - heavyweight
- 1 - lightweight for work
- 1 - heavyweight for work

ACCESSORIES

- 1 - pair of sunglasses
- 2 - ties
- 1 - pair of gloves
- 1 - wallet
- 1 - electric razor (basic, simple no attachments)

LETTERS, CORRESPONDENCE, ETC.

All personal letters, papers, pictures, etc. collected at the Center are to be kept in one (1) box (shoe box size) Writing pad, pens, stamps, envelopes will only be issued through our Commissary. No pornographic material/pictures, no toothpaste, no paste, no tape for hanging photos. No papers, letters, etc. brought in from the outside will be allowed. Photo containing gang-related signs or gestures are prohibited and/or will be confiscated.

NAIL CARE

NO nail polish, polish remover or nail glue (super glue, etc.) of any kind allowed in the Center.

LADIES MAKE-UP

- 1 - each of the following items: liquid/or cream foundation, blush compact, powder compact, mascara, lipstick, eye shadow palette, lip liner, eye liner.

Upon entering the center bring all clothing in plastic bags. Bags will be disposed of upon admission.

Hygiene articles will be issued upon admission.
